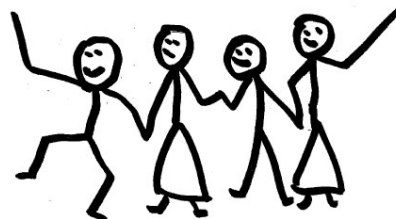
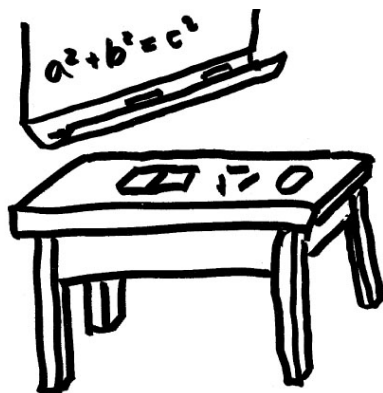

- ▶ They feel lack of on-the-job training.



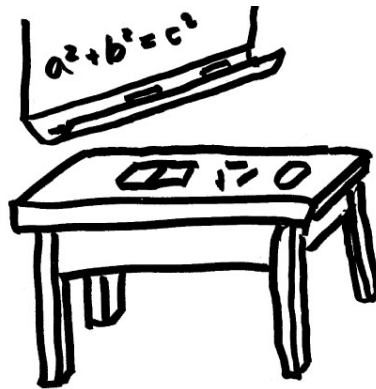
LABOUR MARKET

LACK OF INFORMATION CONCERNING THE LABOUR MARKET

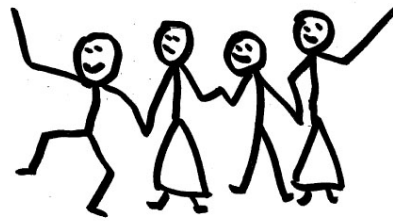

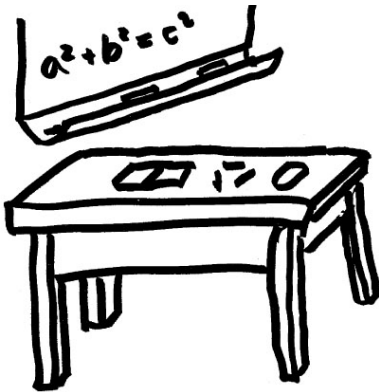

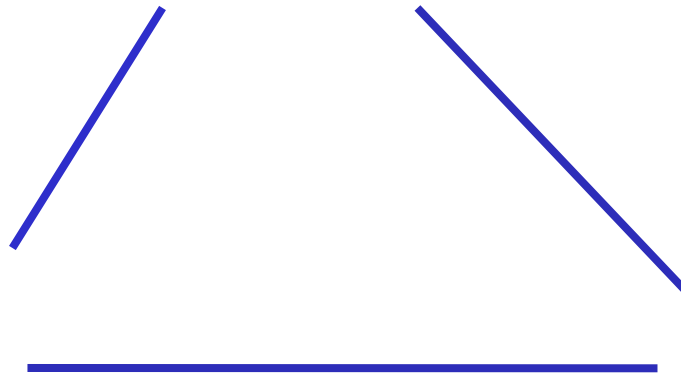
